## MAP SKILLS AND

Our work this term will concentrate on maps skills and finding out about lakes.

The children will have opportunities to read maps using 4 and 6 figure grid references.

We can practice these skills when we take a field trip to the countryside to look closer at lakes and reservoirs.



#### **SHAPES, SPACE AND MEASURES**

This term, we will be using our knowledge of converting between measurements to reason and solve problems. We will also be measuring and drawing angles and using co-ordinates.

Lines of symmetry will be recognised and shapes completed. Properties of shapes will be revised.

## WITCHES AND WIZARDS

During literacy we will be reading texts with the theme of witches and wizards. The children will write in different genres including a biography, story writing and instructions. There will be opportunities for role play and spell casting!



# Patterns in Art

In art, our focus will be different type of pattern. The children will be screen printing their designs.



## **CREATING SOUNDS**

In Science we will look at how sounds are made, how they travel and create our own sounds and string telephones. We will use ICT to measure sound around the school. Investigations will be planned and carried out.

In this area we will be discussing and discovering why Jesus is important to Christians. We will find out about some of his teachings.
