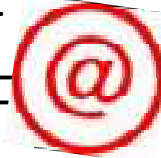
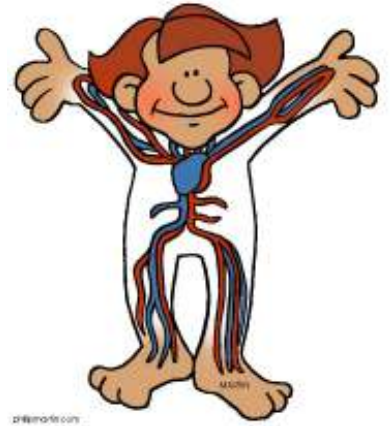


## Science
