Literacy

During this term, 5T we will be exploring the poem 'Albert and the Lion' by Marriott Edgar.

We will be investigating the range of vocabulary used in the poem and how the style of writing effects the meaning of the text. We will also be looking at informal and formal writing and develop our knowledge of technical vocabulary.

We will be writing character descriptions about the different characters which come across in the poem. Then, we will be acting out the characters thoughts and feelings to put into a diary entry of Wallace the Lion. We will also be writing letters of complaint to the zoo from Albert's family and then become detectives to write police reports.

Maths

In maths this term, we will be learning statistics and fractions. The children will be using their knowledge of these areas of maths, to solve a range of problem solving activities and putting these skills into real-life situations.

The children are continuing using Mathletics, which they can access on the computer at school and at home.

Times Tables Rockstar's is still taking place every day at school, so please encourage your child to learn their tables at home.

Science



This term in Science we will be learning about Animals including humans. We will be exploring about the different changes which happen to humans through the stages of life. Then we will use our knowledge of humans and compare similarities and differences of gestation with mammals and birds.

R.E.

We will be learning about the topic 'why do some people believe God exists?'. We will investigate why people believe in God and investigate facts, beliefs and opinions on different arguments people believe in about God. We will also investigate on what Christians believe in and how the world began and make decisions on if all people believe in God. This learning will allow us to prepare and make a balanced argument.

History

In our history this term, we will be exploring the notorious Vikings. We will understand where in the world they came from and why did they settle in Britain. We will explore what they succeeded and failed and learn about key figures such as Cnut the Great.

Other curriculum areas

Art – in Art we will be focusing on Norse artefacts, which is linked to our Viking topic. **Computing** – we will be using a range of digital media.

Music – we will listening to 'Make you feel my love' by Adele and performing the song.
