Welcome back to class 3B summer term. We will be focusing on a range of new topics this half term which we are excited to share with you in our newsletter.

## Literacy

Our English work this term will be linked to our History topic on The Romans. The children will be creating reports, manifestos, fact files, as well as writing and performing plays.

Year 3 are focusing on grammar, spellings and punctuation throughout the term and the children will be writing sentences including adjectives, conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions.



## Numeracy

The main areas of study this term will be on fractions, learning how to order and compare as well as measurement where children will be looking at the perimeter of a shape. Children will be solving number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.

We will also be continuing with Times Table Rockstars so please encourage your child to learn their times tables at home.



## History

This term in history we will be learning about The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. Children will be given the opportunity to research who the Romans were, where they came from, their impact and invasion of Britain. We will explore the story of Boudicca, unsuccessful and successful invasions as well as produce a model of Hadrian's Wall. Year 3 will also be visiting the city Chester to increase their understanding at the Dewa Roman Experience.
