
We will developing our writing, by writing our own version of myths to retell to each other. We also will be writing our own diary entries, newspapers, letters and recounts. These will be presented in different forms for display in our classroom

### Maths

In maths this term, we will learning place value, addition, subtraction multiplication and division.

The children will be using their knowledge of these areas of maths, to solve a range of problem solving activities.

The children should continue with their Mathletics learning, which they can access on the computer at school and at home. Times Tables Rockstars is still taking place every day at school, so please encourage your children to learn their tables at home.



## **Science**

This term we are investigating materials and their properties. We will be investigating mixtures and solutions and how these can be separated, using filtering, sieving and evaporation. We will also be understanding the difference between reversible and irreversible changes by using our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases.

# R.E.

We will be learning about worship in different faiths and the festivals that are celebrated at this time of year. We have are looking forward to exciting trips which the children will visit during this term. We are planning to visit the Shree Ambaji Mandir and The Reformed Synagogue in Manchester as part of our RE work. The children will have the opportunity to look inside the temple and synagogue and to discuss how people worship there.

#### History

In our history this term, we will be exploring the fascinating Ancient Greece. We will be learning about how they lived, what their cultures were and how the Ancient Greeks impact on our daily lives. 

# **Other curriculum areas**

Art – in Art we will be focusing on artefacts, which is linked to our Ancient Greek topic. **Computing** – we will be learning word processing skills.

Music – we will be learning the song don't stop believing by Journey.
