<u>Science</u>

The science topic this term is electricity. The children will be building series and parallel circuits including different components such as: batteries, bulbs, switches, buzzers and motors. They will test different materials to see which are conductors or insulators. Later in the term, they will carry out many different practical activities linked to the topic including creating an electromagnet and making a steady hand tester.

Computing

This term the children will be using a program called Flowel4 to input information in order to make lights or other objects work. Flowol 4 allows children to develop logical reasoning and problem solving talents, develop programming skills and explore the world of automatic control systems and robots

Our PE lesson is on Monday afternoon each week so please could you ensure that your child has the correct kit (including trainers for outdoor work) and that the kit stays in school all week.
