MAPS AND EGYPTIANS!

For the first half of the summer term, we will be looking at maps and learning how to read and give up to six figure grid references. We will use maps of the local area for this and also ordnance survey maps. The children will use map symbols to give grid references.

In the second half of the term, we will be travelling back in time to find out about the Ancient Egyptians. We will explore how the pyramids were built and other find other facts.



MORE DECIMALS AND MEASURES

This term, we will be continuing our work on decimals, rounding and ordering them and then using our understanding to solve reasoning problems.

We will also be working on measures such as time, length and angles. Statistics will also be visited – constructing different graphs with various data.

DRAGONS GALORE!

During literacy we will be reading 'How to train your dragon' by Cressida Cowell. From this, the children will write instructions, draw and describe their own dragon and compare the book with the film.



DESK DRAGONS

In the first half term, the children will be using their Design and Technology skills to make a dragon desk tidy. We will recycle plastic bottles and newspaper to make a useful item to store pens, pencils and other stationery bits and pieces in. This will be messy but fun.

CREATING SOUNDS

In Science we will look at how sounds are made, how they travel and create our own sounds and string telephones. We will use ICT to measure sound around the school. Investigations will be planned and carried out.

In this area we will be discussing and discovering why Jesus is important to Christians. We will find out about some of his teachings.
