

Our Visit to The Manchester Reform Synagogue

As part of our R.E. topic we went to Manchester, on 26th November, to visit the synagogue. We learned about how Jewish people in the community worship.



These are the Torah scrolls, they read from these each week throughout the year. The pages are made of parchment and are not allowed to be touched by hand, so they use a special pointer to keep their place.



The scrolls are written in Hebrew.



There are stained glass windows in the Synagogue, each tells a different story. This one tells the story of Moses and the Ten Commandments.
