Home Learning in Reception 27th April


Hello RP

I hope you are well and helping to look after yourselves and your families. Make sure you are exercising regularly and eating fruits and vegetables to keep yourselves healthy. Here are some new activities to try this week.

Literacy

Watch 'Peter Rabbit' on Storyline Online'.

Can you write some sentences to say what 'Peter Rabbit' looks like and what he does?




For phonics can you go on Phonics play and play Pick a picture to practise blending words, choose phase 2 and 3. All activities are free while schools are closed. Enter username: march20 Password: home to access many resources and games for phase 2,3 and 4.

Mathematics

This week practise Halving and Sharing. Halving is when we share objects into two groups. Sharing is when we share objects into different groups. All the groups should have the same number in each. Are these strawberries shared fairly? Why not?

Get 2 teddies and some small toys such as crayons or lego pieces. Start with 4 of the small toys and share them between the 2 teddies. How many do they have each? Share other numbers of objects 2, 6, 8, 10.



Parents can you share some items with your child incorrectly i.e. give yourself more and ask them if it is fair. Can they tell you how to share equally?

At meal and snack times can you help your grown-ups by sharing food equally onto plates such as sharing strawberries for themselves and their siblings.

Play games where cards or counters have to be shared equally between players.

Topic work

We are going to compare where we live to other places in this country and other countries. Think about what you see in a town and what might be different in the countryside. There are often farms in the countryside. Find out about farms on espresso. Go to **Foundation – Understanding the world – Animals Resource box.** Watch the Farm animals video and do the Farm activities.
