## **Home Learning in Reception**

Hello Reception.

We hope you are well and have kept yourselves busy over the last few weeks.

Here are some more tasks for you to have fun with...

## Literacy

Go on espresso and visit – Foundation – Communication and Language – Books – Videos. Watch the video story called 'Ruff'. Talk about what happened with someone in your family. Then go to Activities and complete the comprehension questions on 'Ruff'.

Can you write about one of your teddys? What do they look like? What would they like as a present if it were their birthday? Write some sentences.

For phonics can you go on Phonics play and play Buried Treasure to practise blending words. All activities are free while schools are closed. Enter username: march20 Password: home to access many resources and games for phase 2,3 and 4.

## **Mathematics**

This week practise doubling. When we double numbers, we add the same number together such as 3+3= 6. Play 'Find the Pair' you will need cards with dots. You can make these by drawing dots on card or paper like the ones in the image. Make two sets up to 5 initially. Numbered playing cards will work, use 2 suits. Spread them upside down on table and take turns with a family member to turn two cards over. If you get a pair, say what the double makes i.e. double 3 is 6 and keep the cards.

When you can say the doubles to 5, try to play the game up to 10.

Build two towers using your toys such as blocks or lego. Make them the same height up to 5, then find out what the two towers make.





Two towers of 5 makes 10. 5+5=10

Make a butterfly. Put the same number of dots on both sides. How many dots are there in total?



Double 4 is 8. 4+4 = 8

## **Topic work**

We are going to compare where we live to other places in this country and other countries.

Look out of your window or look around if you go for a walk for daily exercise. What are the features of a town? Can you see shops, garages, clinics or surgeries, a police station, bus stops, a church, a mosque, schools?

Can you draw a map and draw the things you see?

Remember Reception to help your grown-ups around the house. Keep exercising and have fun.
