

Home Learning in Reception

Hello Reception.

We hope you are well and looking after yourselves. Remember to complete the challenges we sent home. Here are a few more ideas which will be updated regularly so keep checking.

Literacy

This week in Literacy we would have been retelling the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

-Tell the story to your parents? Who are the characters? What happens at the beginning? In the middle? And at the end?

-Draw a story map and write a few sentences to tell the story.



Don't forget to learn the phonics sounds on espresso.

Mathematics

This week in Mathematics we would have been learning numbers to 20 and finding out about money.

-Learn to recognise the numbers 1 to 20.

-Talk about the value of the numbers for example 14 is ten and four.

-Order the numbers. There is a sheet in your pack to cut out the numbers and order them or you could make some number cards.

- Choose a number and say one more and one less than your chosen number.

-Look at coins. (These can be images online so you are not touching the coins and picking up germs.)

-Talk about the differences in the coins.

-Begin to add two coins to find a value. For example, a 5p and a 2p coin is 7p. (At this age the children may say 2p for two coins, please ensure your child recognises coins are different values.)



Topic work

This week we would have been finding out about plants we can eat.

-Look at the food in your fridge. Which things have been grown and which has been made?

-Look at vegetables before they are cooked. How do they change? Which part of the plant do you eat?

-Compare different fruits and vegetables that you eat regularly.

-Make a salad. What is your favourite part?
