
Home learning week beginning 15th June 2020.

Literacy

- 1. Draw a picture of what happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story then write a sentence for each picture.
- 2. Focus in on middle part of the story. What happens in the middle? Go through Countryside. What do they see in the countryside? Write a list of what they see.
- 3. Pretend you are going on a train ride. Write about where your train would take you.

Maths

This week we will be learning about doubles 1-10. To begin with can you join in with Jack Hartman to count to 20. Here is the link to help you find it:

Now can you do the following activities.

- 1. Work with some one in your house. Make a number line with some objects, one person has 1-10 objects in a line. Your partner doubles it by making the same quantities.
- 2. Draw some ladybirds. Add 1, 2, 3,4,5 dots to each side of the ladybird. Underneath each ladybird write the sentence 'Double 1 is 2' etc.
- 3. Ask a grown up to make towers 1-10 from bricks or other objects from around your home. Can you make a tower with double the number of bricks?
