

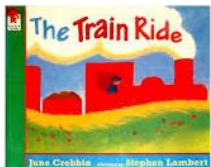
Home learning week beginning 22nd June 2020.

Hello Reception, We hope you are all well and staying safe. Here are your learning activities to complete at home with your families this week.

Literacy

This week we will be reading the story The Train Ride again. You can find this on YouTube. Please read or listen to the story. Here is the link to help you find it:

1. Focus on the end of the story. Where are the girl and her Grandma? At the seaside. Display a picture of a seaside. What can we do at the seaside? Using the seaside as a stimulus children to make up own ending to the story to say what the girl did, for example, The girl splashed in the sea. The girl made sandcastles. Write a sentence.
2. Look at videos on Espresso about the seaside. Write a sentence to say what you can see at the seaside, for example, I can see rocks.

Maths

This week we will be learning about halving and sharing. To begin with can you join in with Jack Hartman to count to 20. Here is the link to help you find it:

Now can you do the following activities.

1. Use 2 teddys, 2 plates and 10 loose objects; these can be beads, money, buttons, sticks etc. Can you share the objects equally with the 2 bears? Did you share them fairly? Talk about one plate being half the total number of objects you have. What will happen if another teddy joins the picnic? Will they all have the same amount? Why?
2. Show the children two plates and some small objects. Tell your child you are going to share them equally. Pick up a handful of the small objects and put them onto each plate, making sure that one plate has more than the other. Ask your child have I shared them fairly? Why? How can I make sure they are shared equally? Can you show me?
3. Ask your child to help set the table for dinner. Give them the plates, knives, forks, spoons, cups and ask them to share them equally between the number of chairs at the table.



Topic

This week we will be learning about the seaside. Can you do the following activities:



1. Find a picture of the seaside on the computer. Write a list of things you can see in the picture.
2. Write a poem about the seaside. Write a sentence for each sense, I can see.... I can hear..... I can smell.... I can taste.... I can feel.
3. Write instructions on how to make a sandcastle
4. Paint/collage/create a seaside scene

Other activities

Other activities that we would like you to do are:

1. Practise washing your hands correctly. Choose a song to sing while you wash your hands.
