

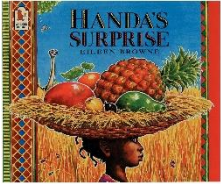
## Home learning week beginning 29th June 2020.

Hello Reception, We hope you are all well and staying safe. Here are your learning activities to complete at home with your families this week.

### Literacy

This week we will be reading the story Handa's Surprise. You can find this on YouTube. Please read or listen to the story. Here is the link to help you find it:

1. Talk about what Handa sees on her journey. Write sentences about her journey, for example, Handa saw a parrot.
2. Talk about why the story is called Handa's Surprise (Handa was surprised there were tangerines in her basket not all the fruit she had in at the beginning of the story). Look at the fruits at the beginning of the story. Write a list. Which animal ate each fruit?
3. Draw a story map to show what happened in the story.

### Maths

This week we will be learning about odd and even numbers. To begin with can you join in with Jack Hartman to count to 20. Here is the link to help you find it:

Now can you do the following activities.

1. Give the children some objects and ask them to make the quantities 1-10. Explain to the children that we will be learning about odd and even numbers and that we can find out by putting each quantity into pairs. Ask your child to put each quantity into pairs. Can we put all the quantities into pairs? Why? Explain that if all the objects can be put into pairs it is an even number if any object is left over it is an odd number
2. Give your child some pots labelled 1-10. Ask the children to put the correct number of objects into each pot. Ask your child to tell you if each pot is odd or even. How do you know? How can we check?
3. Take a walk along your street. Look at the door numbers on each door. Decide if the number is odd or even. What do you notice? (all the odds on one side of the road and all the evens on the other side of the road).



### Topic

This week we will be learning about the hot countries. Can you do the following activities:



1. Look at a place where you go on holiday. Talk about it being hotter than England. Talk about why people like to go on holiday. Draw a picture of where you go on holiday and write a sentence to say why you like going on holiday.
2. Find out about the plants and animals that live in the jungle. Write a list. Do we have these animals in England?
3. Choose one hot country. Write some facts about what the weather is like, what people wear, where people live, what animals live there, what plants grow there.

### Other activities

Other activities that we would like you to do are:

1. Practise washing your hands correctly. Choose a song to sing while you wash your hands.
2. Go on Numbots and complete 1 challenge on the game.
3. Take part in a yoga session with Cosmic Kids. Here is a link to help you.
