Literacy:

This week I would like you to:

- 1. Read the story together and talk about what happens.
- 2. Talk about the characters and how the story is different from The Three Little Pigs.
- 3. Practice sequencing the story using the sequencing pictures.

Story sequencing

Order the sequencing pictures and think of a sentence for each picture. Write your sentence underneath (make marks for your writing).

Story map

Create a story map on paper. Draw pictures of the main events and then connect them with an arrow. See the example in your pack for ideas.

Name writing

Practice writing your name using large paper on the floor/table. Remember to form the letters correctly!

Maths:

Continue to practice the Jack Hartmann songs:

- 1. Practice counting to 10 and 20.
- 2. Continue to practice counting objects and saying how many.
- 3. Put the objects in a line, count them and say how many. Push the objects together and talk about how the total is still the **same**.
- 4. Order objects by size. Talk about which is big/small.

5. <u>Creative:</u>

Create a bear from the story. You could use paint, collage materials or household objects to create your bears face. Think about what bears need and what colour they are (eyes, ears, claws etc)











Other activities

- 1. Can you make some porridge? There is a recipe in your pack.
- 2. Practice throwing and catching a ball. Throw the ball underarm to a friend/ family member and try to catch it as they throw it back.
- 3. Practice writing and drawing pictures outside. This might be on large paper outdoors, with chalk on the floor or with water on the floor.
