LO: To practise implementing the style of David Hockney in our own work.

Today you will have an opportunity to practise landscapes in the style of David Hockney. Remember what you observed last week? Hockney uses unusual and contrasting colours for effect, as well as a spectrum of one colour to create depth and texture.

Look around your home/garden. Select a small area to sketch as your own landscape. Can you add colour to this? If you have paints, try to create texture and depth by using varied shades of the same colour. If you don't, how could you achieve this effect with crayons? (Felt tips will not be the best medium for this activity). If you have no colours at all, make your sketch and annotate how you would add colour if you could.

You will need to do this on a separate piece of paper. You can save it to bring to school on Monday 5th, or take a picture and upload it.
