Learning:

Today we are looking at expanded noun phrases! Hopefully you will remember these from previous year groups and be a whizz at them!

What are expanded noun phrases?

This is usually done by adding adjectives to describe the noun in the noun phrase, for example:

She walked through the dark, mysterious forest.

In the example above, the expanded noun phrase is 'the dark, mysterious forest', the words 'dark' and 'mysterious' have been used to expand the noun phrase.
