5. DCXX - L
6. ML - C

Key for Roman numerals:

I = 1

V = 5

X = 10

L = 50

C = 100

D = 500

M = 1000

4. A digital camera cost £6841.89 before Christmas. It is reduced by £5120.45 in the New Year's sale. What is the new price?
5. It is 4275km from Fife to London. Jake travels in 3 stages. He travels 2880km, takes a break, then travels another 1350km and takes another break. How many km does he need to travel in the 3rd stage of his journey to reach London?
6. A family has a budget of £457,668 for the total cost of a holiday. They spend £11,098 on flights and £125,550 on accommodation, how much will they have left for spending money?
7. A mum buys 24,750 millilitres of pop for a child's party. The children drink 16,840 millilitres of the pop. How much pop is left?
8. A ribbon is 751,550m long. A piece 365,120m in length is used, and then a second piece 223,210 m is used. How much ribbon is left?
