Hello Reception,

Here are the things we have planned to learn in school for this week. If you are at home, please work on these activities.

### **Literacy**

Listen to the story of The Little Red Hen on You Tube

Talk about the characters. Should the animals have helped the Little Red Hen? Were you happy when The Little Red Hen ate the bread by herself?

Who are the characters? Ask your child to make puppets of the characters.

Ask your child to tell you the story using the puppets.

Talk about different types of bread you eat at home and how it is grown.

### **For phonics**

Watch the videos on Espresso for g,σ,c,k (You will need the log in details given at the beginning of term)

Try to find things around your house that begin with these sounds.

Write the sounds, hold your pencil in the tripod grip. Form your letters correctly as above starting at the top.

### **Mathematics**

Look at number books.

This week we are learning about 'more' and 'fewer'. Using toys or food in your home put some on one plate and some on another plate. Which plate has more? Which has fewer?

Get out 3 toys. Ask your child to get out more toys than you. Who has more? Who has fewer?

Using a building type toy have a race building a tower in 10 seconds. Who has more blocks in their tower? Who has fewer? Which tower is taller?

### **Topic work**

I hope you enjoyed your fruit salad last week. This week we are finding out about Autumn.

Can you look out of your window to find signs of Autumn? Draw some of the things you can see.

### **Mathematics**

This week we are learning continuing work on 'more' and 'fewer' and 'same'.

Ask your child to get a handful of a small item such as pencils or pasta shapes. You get some, different to your child and fewer than 5. Ask who has more? Who has fewer? Put them in two lines to check. Count how many you each have. Repeat. You can also try getting the same amount as your child and ask, "Who has more?" Can they explain why no one has more?

Make a number board like the one below. Choose a number to use. Use objects around your house and place them in the correct places.
