In reading we will be:

In maths we will be:

- We will be comparing their achievements and looking at different aspects of life in different time periods.

In science we will be:

- Exploring animals including humans and describing the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different foods and hygiene.

In RE we will be:

- Exploring how and why people celebrate special and sacred times.
- Identifying a special time they celebrate and explain simply what celebration means.

In PSHE we will be:

- Exploring relationships.
- How to listen to other people and play and work cooperatively
- How to talk about and share their opinions on things that matter to them can affect others
- About how to treat themselves and others with respect; how to be polite and courteous

In computing we will be:

- Creating pictures and using technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content in the context of using a computer program to recreate an artistic style.

In art/D&T we will be:

- Applying the principles of healthy eating and nutrition.
- Finding out about where our food comes from.

In PE we will be:

- Developing skills with Miss Mather including throwing, catching, hitting targets and taking part in a variety of games.
