Literacy

For phonics

This week we are starting Phase 3 phonics. We will be learning the sounds y, z, and qu. Use the phonics section on Espresso to learn about these sounds. Complete some of the activities that are on Espresso for these sounds.

Write a list of words that begin with each sound.

Mathematics

Look at number books.

This week we are learning to make the numbers 2, 3, 4 and 5.

- Use bricks, cars or any other toys you have at home to show all the different ways to make the numbers 2, 3, 4 and 5. Take photographs of each idea you have.
- Have 1 hoop or box on the floor. Give your child 5 balls or objects they can throw into the box or the hoop. Ask your child to throw as many as they can into the box/hoop. How many landed in the box? How many landed outside the box? How many do you have altogether?
- Have 5 objects, give your child some of the objects. How many more do we need to make 2? Repeat for the numbers 3,4 and 5.

Topic work

This week is all about light sources. Look on Espresso to find out what light sources are.

- Make a list of the light sources in your house.
- Draw and label pictures of different light sources.
- Find out about Hanukkah on Espresso. Who celebrates this festival? How do they celebrate it? What is the similar to the way we celebrate Eid? What is different to the way we celebrate Eid? Use junk modelling resources to make a Menorah.
