

Home Learning in Reception Week beginning 2nd November

Hello Reception,

Here are the things we have planned to learn in school for this week. If you are isolating at home, please work on these activities. Please bring your work into school when you have finished your isolation for us to see. Thank you.

Literacy

This week we are finding out about Bonfire night and thinking about the sounds you hear on Bonfire night. Go on espresso to watch a video about Bonfire night. Go to:

There are also some activities you can do on espresso.

Draw a picture of fireworks and a bonfire and think about the sounds you hear, Listen for the first sound in the word i.e. fffffizz, pppppop, zzzzzoom, bbbbang,

Use the sound mat at site below to find the sound to copy.

Talk about firework safety. There is a firework safety code on the activities on espresso Bonfire night.

Look at pictures of Bonfires and fireworks on Google images.

Talk about the colours and shapes and say a sentence about them.



For phonics

Recap all the sounds learnt so far from s to r. (see sound mat above) Say the sound for each one and name something that begins with that sound. Find some items in your home that have 3 sounds in them such as a mug, cup, peg, hat, map. Sound out an object for your child to find i.e. the c-u-p. Your child points to the correct item. Ask them to be 'teacher' and use robot talk to sound out an object for you to find.

Play Buried treasure. Choose a sound up to r to practise reading the words on the coins and put them in the treasure if they are real and bin if they are made up.

Mathematics

Look at number books.

This week we are learning continuing work on 1 more than a given number. Watch 'The Enormous Turnip' on You Tube. Talk about how many people they are each time one more is added.

Draw a 5 frame

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Put one object in it. Ask your child how many are there? Put one more object in the 5 frame. How many are there now? Add one more each time and say how many.

Next put 3 object in. How many are there? Ask your child to predict how many there will be if one more is added. Repeat this with different numbers.

Topic work

This week is all about Bonfire Night. Explain it is a cultural celebration from a long time ago when some men wanted to kill the king but were stopped. Find out about some traditions such as treacle toffee, toffee apples, and the 'Remember remember...' chant. Draw pictures.

If you have paints, ask your child to mix colours to explore what they make i.e. red and yellow make orange. Make a firework picture with the different colours.

In RE we are talking about different celebrations. Talk about how you celebrate different events in your family.
