Can you now construct a bar chart to show the information that you have collected? Remember to label the vertical and horizontal axes, think carefully about the intervals of numbers. Don't forget to use a ruler. Can you write three questions about your graph for someone else to answer?</p>	<p>Use the numbers 1-20, how many multiplication sentences can you make? (There are a lot of possibilities!)</p>	<p>What can these numbers be divided by without a remainder? 72, 96, 48, 120, 84, 126 Each one can be divided by more than one number. Can you find all the possibilities?</p>
<p>How many ways can you make 100 by adding three numbers together.
