In reading we will be:

- reading 'Who let the Gods out?' as part of our literacy lessons
- inferring characters feelings and making predictions based on clues within the text
- referring to the text when justifying views
- looking at different genres of text

In writing we will be:

- writing a non-chronological report about the city of Athens
- writing predictions using characters from our book 'Who let the Gods out?'
- write a character description
- write a newspaper article about Zeus and Petunia's wedding
- write the next chapter in a book

In maths we will be:

- recognising numbers up to and including 1,000,000
- rounding numbers up to 1,000,000 using 10s, 100s and 1000s
- adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers using 2 and above exchanges
- using the inverse operation to check calculations
- interpreting charts to analyse data

In history/geography we will be:

- studying the life and achievements of the Ancient Greeks.
- learning how they impacted the lifestyle of modern day Western people.

In science we will be:

- learning about the properties of materials
- learning how materials can be changed in reversible and irreversible changes

In RE we will be:

- learning about who God is to a variety of faiths
- finding out the importance of worship and what it might look like
- understanding that different religions worship in different ways
- understanding the impact of attending a place of worship

In PSHE we will be:

- understanding what it means to have a personal identity.
- understanding all about stereotypes and how they shouldn't be assumed when thinking about personal identity.

In computing we will be:

- talking confidently about cyber-bullying and how to prevent and respond to it
- developing an understanding of personal safety when using devices and the possible implications of misuse
- learning the risks of communication and accessing resources from the internet



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In art/D&T we will be:

- exploring Greek foods
- designing our own savoury Greek dish
- tasting Greek foods
- making our own dish and evaluating the finished product
