In reading we will be:

- reading 'Little Red Hiding Hood,' 'The Highway Rat' and 'The London Bus' as part of our literacy lessons.
- describing characters referring to the text.
- Identifying language patterns in text.

In writing we will be:

- Writing character descriptions
- Writing letters.
- Writing poetry.
- Writing fictional narrative.

In maths we will be:

- Counting forward and backwards within 20.
- Tens and ones within 20.
- Counting forwards and backwards within 50.
- Compare numbers within 50.
- Add a two digit and one digit number—crossing 10.
- Subtraction crossing 10
- Subtract a one-digit number from a two digit number – crossing 10.

In history/geography we will be:

- Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.
- Look at features of our school and its grounds.
- Looking at human and physical features of different locations.

In science we will be:

- Looking at plants and identifying and describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants including trees.
- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature in order to survive.

In RE we will be:

- Looking at ways we belong and identifying what is special and of value about belonging to a group that is important to them.
- We will compare and contrast stories from different religions about belonging.

In PSHE we will be:

- Exploring friendship.
- Identifying different feelings and how to deal with them in a positive way.
- Finding ways to stay safe in and around school.

In computing we will be:

- Exploring ways to keep safe whilst using computers and the internet.
- Looking at passwords and their significance.

In art/D&T we will be:

 Exploring ideas for design by comparing differences and similarities in designer's work and make our own pattern design inspired by nature using a variety of different mediums.

In PE we will be:

 Developing skills such as throwing, catching, balancing and exploring a variety of different movements before moving onto circuits.
