Headteacher	Make contact with emergency services and have the following information available:

	 Teachers and support staff: stay with pupils – follow your classroom's individual plan and ensure that you have your crisis response kit available.

Evacuation signal	Fire alarm sound would mean everyone needs to evacuate

Assembly points	Please see individualised plans			
	General – stay in classroom,or make your way to the nearest classroom if you are in the hall or playground.			

Entrance and exit points	General: Teachers to secure their area within and close to their classroom. Ensure all doors and windows are locked.				
	Entrances – doors should always be locked but class teachers to check the nearest external doors to their classroom before locking their classroom door. Site manager and members of SLT to check that all external doors are locked.				
	Windows: Teachers to ensure all windows to classrooms are closed/ locked.				
	Site manager and SLT to secure the doors that are closet to their current location.				
Bringing pupils inside	Playground: Return to classroom immediately, staff to register pupils to ensure that all children are inside. If any children are missing, this needs to be communicated immediately via channel 1.				
	Astro turf and field:				
	Return to classroom immediately, staff to register pupils to ensure that all children are inside. If any children are missing, this needs to be communicated immediately via channel 1.				
Steps to increase	Turn walkie talkie to channel 1				
protection from danger	Lock doors				
	Close windows				
	Draw blinds and/ or shutters where available				
	 Position children away from sightlines from external doors and windows, for example under a desk 				
	Turn off lights and monitors				
	Ensure mobiles phones and electronic devices are on silent				
Internal communication	Walkie talkie				
	Mobile phones				
	Email system				
Communication with	A combination of text and email to contact parents				
parents	Ask parents not to call the school, as this will tie up lines that would be used to contact emergency services, and not to come to the school.				
Additional notes	Remember to dispense medicine and ensure that all medical needs				

are met during this time.

Use signal to initiate lockdown				
Ensure pupils are inside				
Secure entrance points				
Contact emergency services				
Ensure staff take action to increase protection from danger [you could list specific actions that you will take in your school here, such as turning off lights and locking internal doors]				
Make sure pupils and staff are aware of exit points				
If safe, check for missing pupils or staff				
Remain inside until all clear has been given or told to evacuate

First aid kit
Walk Talkies
Torch and batteries
High Viz Jackets
Mobile phone charger
Travel potty
Bottled water for classrooms without running water
