In reading we will be:

- Know and use the vocabulary of prime numbers, prime
- Establishing whether a number up to 100 is prime and

In writing we will be:

- writing an instructional text about defeating mythical
- Taking on the role of an important historical figure to write a diaru
- Using persuasive language to create job adverts
- Writing biographical texts about historical figures.

In maths we will be:

- factors and composite (non-prime) numbers.
- recall prime numbers up to 19.
- Recognise and use squared numbers and the notation for squared (2)

In history/geography we will be:

- Learning about the impact of the Ancient Greeks on modern day mathematics and science.
- Investigating the creation of modern day government through democracy that was first implemented by the
- Exploring the role of women in Ancient Greek times
- Compare modern Greece and Ancient Greece

In science we will be:

- Discovering the mysteries of the universe through our Earth and Space topic.
- Explaining how planets move in our solar system.
- Identifying scientific evidence which does and does not provide evidence for an idea or argument.
- Explaining day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

In RE we will be:

- Learning about if God is real and the opinions of Christians.
- Finding out why people believe or do not believe in God.
- Looking at if God is real and why people believe he exists.
- Looking at how Christians believe the world began and whether or not they all share the same view.

In PSHE we will be:

- Explaining some financial risks we might encounter and can discuss how we can avoid them.
- Learning how retailers try to influence our spending
- Learning what 'value for money' means and can explain how to tell if things are good value.

In computing we will be:

- creating a range of hyperlinks to produce a non-linear presentation
- creating effects and music and import from other sources
- Selecting and importing sounds from your own recordings
- Formatting and editing work to improve consistency, clarity and mood.

In art/D&T we will be:
