

# Parents Meeting: Year 1 Phonic Screening Check

What can you do to help at home?

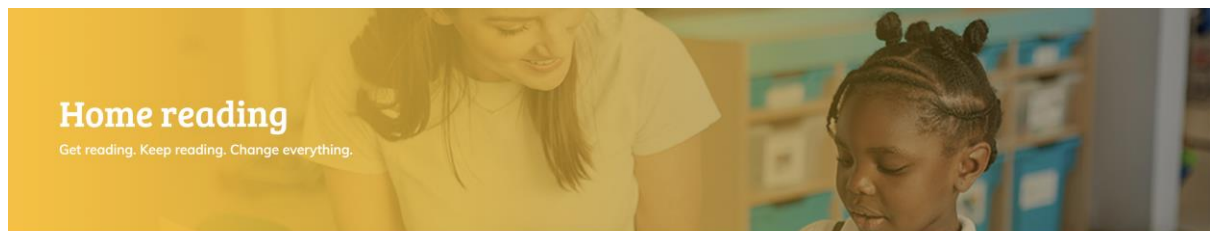
1. Use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', read the word, to read words.
2. Practise reading sounds speedily - 'review, review, review'.
3. Listen to your child read their *Read Write Inc.* Storybook every day.

**Examples of previous phonics screening check materials are available online.** Here is a list which you could write onto paper and practice with your child at home. We do not want the children to learn these by heart, but to be able to decode nonsense words, so do not be afraid to make up your own.
