Parents' Evening

Building Work

During the February half term holiday, our new building project started. This is to create some new learning spaces for our pupils. We are not admitting more pupils into the school but creating more space for the children taught in small groups during the school day. We are also going to have a larger main entrance built. This work will continue throughout the school year and the aim is for it to be completed by December 2024. This will cause some disruption to the KS2 playground as it has been fenced off to ensure our pupils are kept safe at all times. If you use some of the paths at the back of the school near the Year 6 and Year 5 classes, they have also been closed off, so you may have to walk around the other way. I apologise for the inconvenience but the work does need completing in order to improve the teaching space in the school.

The school office will also be moved to a temporary cabin on the KS1 playground during the May half term holiday so when your children return, the office staff will be on the KS1 playground. I will inform you of the changes closer to the time.

School Comms is replacing Parent Mail

We are gradually phasing out Parent Mail and aim to have all parents/carers signed up to Schoolcomms before the summer holidays.

We would really appreciate it if parents/carers could sign up as soon as possible to ensure that all communication is being received from school. This also means that only one app is used for communication and payments.

This can be accessed through an app on your phone called **School Gateway** and is very easy to use. Once downloaded and registered, all communication and payments will be processed through the app.
