Christmas Parties

Our Christmas parties will take place on Friday 19th December in the afternoon. Children can come to school all day in their party clothes.

<u>Christmas Jumper and</u> <u>Dinner Day</u>

Christmas dinner will take place on Friday 12th December for all those children on school dinners. If you would like your child to have a Christmas dinner instead of their packed lunch for that day, then please speak to the school office about making the payment. Children can wear a Christmas jumper/ dress/ t shirt on this day if they have one.

Packed Lunches

If your child is on packed lunches/ sandwiches, then please think about the food they are given. We often see children with chocolate waffles, chocolate brioche rolls and chocolate sandwiches. Try to swap these for pieces of fruit or a yoghurt. Some children are bringing burgers or food that has been cooked either in the morning or the night before. We have no way of keeping this food in the fridge or warm due to the vast number of children in our school. A cold burger cooked in the morning can harm you if it is left at room temperature for more than two hours.

OPAL Playtime and lunchtime

Please make sure your child has a coat with them each day.

Year 3, 4, 5 and 6- if your child has a spare pair of old trainers or shoes that they could change into at lunchtime, then please send them into school. This will avoid their school shoes getting wet or muddy at lunchtime.
